96/33 Woolmer Link

A complaint had been received from a local resident asking why the road plan had been changed.

The Parish Council agreed that the time for objections regarding the link were back at the time of the local exhibition in the village hall when all the plans for the road were on display, when no objections were received about the new plans, so this would have been the time to object as this complaint was after construction of the road had already began.

Mr Onslow offered to look into it and reply to the residents concerned.

Traffic Calming - After a successful walk around the village with Mr Soutar and several Councillors it was decided to have a slot in the A P M for Mr Soutar to talk about early ideas for the scheme and ask the villagers for suggestions before the final plan takes shape.

As there has been an appeal regarding the crematorium at Ham barn, there will now be a Public enquiry.

Mr Flack suggested that the Parish Council should carry out a survey of the village to get the general feeling.

He asked all councillors to give their suggestions of questions and all meet up to set up a questionnaire.

Mrs Jenkinson asked the Parish council to give the millenium some thought - What are we going to do as a Parish.

If we find out what other local organisations are going to do ie.school,church etc. So we could draw up a plan of activities.

Maybe a committee should be set up with a representative from each organisation to co-ordinate an agenda of events avoiding any duplicates.


Mrs Jenkinson suggested that the Clerk should write to the local organisations within the Parish to see if they would elect a representative and keep a log of the committee.
