96/32 (a) Mrs Jenkinson asked what the situation of the Old Church was at. Mr Flack informed us that Mr Hooker is waiting for a reply about repairing the wall outside before we take it over.

(b) The Clerk informed the Parish Council that she is still waiting for a reply from the Foster family about filling in the family vault.

(c) Mr Flack informed the Parish Council that EHDC had written to L'Abri asking them to repair the wall outside the Old Church within 14 days as they had been called out to clean the highway of its remains and would charge them in future. The letter was passed onto us and we have been in touch with EHDC to tell them who is responsible.
