96/88 Millenium Celebrations

98/90 The Old Church

1. It was reported that the conveyance had been executed - The Parish council is pleased that this matter has finally been resolved.
2. Mrs Jenkinson reported that Doug Curry at "Old School House" has rubbish between his property and Old Church and is keen to tidy it up - this was agreed by the Parish Council.
3. Mrs Jenkinson suggested that Doug should hold a key to the Old Church and open it up during the day, the Parish Council agreed. The Manor also hold a key.
4. Now the Parish council own the Old Church it was agreed to form a trust to get funding - Mrs Jenkinson is happy to contact Sir James Scott and Kevin Stubbs for further information , possibly "Friends of Greatham Old Church Trustees " and then associate members.

98/91 Traffic calming / cycle track

1. David Onslow reported that EHDC and HCC had taken on board the wish for a cycleway through the village.
2. It was also noted that heavy lorries and traffic is increasing though the village.
3. PC Moyce - crossing patrol - reported that the increase in traffic has been noted bt the Police and will consult with his traffic sergeant on possible deterrents and possible leverage with HCC.
4. David Redman reported that at the EHDAPC meeting - a great deal of concern was expressed about safety of the A325 (not just through Greatham) It was agreed to write to the County Surveyors about backing up Whithills concerns.
