98/03 Matters arising:-

School Bins - Report received from HCC Landscaper. Unfortunately, bins not included in proposals. GA suggested using hurdle fencing and planting around. (Mrs Mitchell has again complained bins are overflowing). Miss Badawi is getting back to HCC to specifically ask for their recommendations on the bins. Area to be measured to decide how many hurdles would be needed (DR to do this). Recommended that hurdles erected asap. GA has contact in Petersfield - would cost £20-£30 per hurdle.

Gardeners' Club - Cant go any further with their proposal until all traffic calming finished. Write back to inform them of this.

98/07 Finance:-

98/08 Traffic Calming:-

Public meeting Thursday with Steve Venton, Geoff Topps and Dave Pickett. Referring to previous meeting about concerns over safety of build-outs positions. Safety Audit meeting held earlier this week. Told initially that trials would be removed today, however at meeting HCC volunteered to leave them in until the end of November. HCC now prepared to 'tinker' with position of build-outs. Local opinion seems to be build-outs should be moved further apart. HCC to come up with alternatives. Carry on with other traffic calming down to other end of village while decisions are made.

HCC not prepared to look at speed limit through village until next summer. JW to look into speeding this up. Plan received from HCC regarding road at village shop end. GA has put a copy up in shop. BC has taken original plan.

Signs - Position has now been changed from original information given to Council. Now by Jardinique and Manor Cottage. Write to HCC once again saying displaying 40mph signs when road may be changed to 30mph seems pointless. Cannot see why lower limit can't be introduced in near future. Signs also too big.

HCC need to get agreement from Parish Council to move part of the green. We have Conveyance to provide proof of Old Church and HCC also need proof of ownership of green. JW said County Secretary would have original Deeds to village green.

We need to confirm to HCC about continuing with trials.

98/09 The Old Church:-

Insurance - Insurance company will not insure ruin for vandalism or storm damage as it doesn't have a roof. Chancel has to be valued and they will insure for the vandalism and storm damage based on that. Kevin Stubbs may know something about how to get valuation.

The date (28 November) for tidying of grounds has not gone in Parish magazine as last meeting was held past deadline for articles. Let date stand and see who turns up.
