

# GREATHAM PARISH COUNCIL

A MEETING OF THE PARISH COUNCIL WAS HELD AT GREATHAM VILLAGE HALL ON MONDAY 21<sup>ST</sup> JUNE 1999 AT 7.30PM

99/02 Village Map Presentation:-

A presentation was given by Mr Sal Cardu of Euroforce Promotions. Everyone was agreed that the map was very appealing. An A3 size was considered sufficient. A print run of 500 was discussed and the price for this would be pro-rata the 300 print run price quoted. PG has spoken to the companies who showed interest in sponsorship and this is to be followed up by letter asking them for a donation of £100 (this sum was voted on and unanimously agreed). Sal Cardu informed the Council that if the companies wish their logo to be put scanned onto the map this costs an extra £10.

He mentioned that aerial photography would be required and will cost £375 + VAT. Judy Onslow/John West are to look into any possible Council aerial photos already in existence.

99/11 The Old Church:-


