- F.32554/006/LBC Installation of garage doors to end wall - Brockbridge Farmhouse, Blackmoor, (Selborne Parish)

- F.25524/026/FUL 1st floor extension and new vehicular access to stables - Kings Holt Cottage, Greatham
Application has been with EE for the last 4 weeks and deadline has passed. Was discussed at meeting, a vote taken and it was agreed to refuse this application (ADH abstained as she felt she could not vote on an application she hadn't actually been able to review).

GA stated that planning applications must be circulated around the planning sub-committee within a reasonable time to allow all members to have a proper look at them and they must be returned by the deadline.

Re. the complaints over noise levels in the workshops adjacent to Jardinque. EE said that as far as he was aware this business has been given notice to quit.

Mr Mills re. Land at Church Lane. EHDC inform us that there is no enforcement notice and that the shelter/barn standing on this land at present has passed the current period of enforcement time anyway.

99/07 Finance:-

Chq to Portsmouth City Council for £19.97 for neighbourhood watch sign.

It was agreed to increase the clerk's wages to pay for 4 hours work a week instead of 3 due to increase in workload.

Chq signed for clerk's wages for 6 months to 30.9.99 for £653.12 plus £62.66 expenses

99/08 Traffic Calming:-

Have heard from HCC that they will be replacing the trial near Bakersfield with 3 build outs, scheduled for November.

Still awaiting replies to other outstanding matters.

No amenities plans as yet forthcoming re. tree planting - Clerk is continuing to chase.

Need to check into the lamppost outside the Manor - should it have been changed to an old style lamppost?

GA suggested resiting the flagpole to the churchyard. It was decided to put this and the outstanding issue of the church noticeboard on the agenda for the next mtg. In meantime write to PCC asking their approval in principle to relocating the flagpole to the churchyard.

99/09 The Old Church:-

Next Trustees mtg is on 1.11. On 6.11 there is a working party.

The war memorial and bench in new churchyard are parish council responsibility and having been informed of their bad condition DR & GA have cleaned the memorial and teak oiled the bench. Need to make a note to do this annually.

99/10 Playground:-

Ltr from Tim Gould re applying for grants which said this would be easier for the VHC to do. It was discussed at length and decided to arrange a public mtg to set up an independent group with representation from both the council and the VHC as well as members of the public. It was agreed that Bill Budd should chair this mtg. Clerk to arrange this for 3rd week in November.

ADH to look at and then bring to next mtg.


