

**GREATHAM PARISH COUNCIL**  
**MINUTES of the MEETING HELD at GREATHAM VILLAGE HALL on**  
**MONDAY, 5<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY, 2004, at 7.00pm.**

**04.001: PRESENT.**

Councillors E.Evans (Chairman); J. Lodder; M. Chenell; D.Jerrard; A. Booton; A. Bridgman, and three members of the public.

**04.002: OPEN SESSION.**

A fifteen minute period was provided for questions from the public, but none were forthcoming.

**04.003: APOLOGIES for ABSENCE.**

All appointed members being present, there were no apologies for absence.

**04.004: APPOINTMENT of REPRESENTATIVES** (deferred from November).

On proposal by D. Jerrard, seconded by J. Lodder, the following appointments were unanimously agreed;

- (viii) Coryton Almshouses Trust: D. Jerrard

**04.005: MINUTES of LAST MEETING.**

The minutes of the meeting of 22/12/03 were considered. After Minute 03.116 was amended to show the sum of £16,300, rather than £15,900, it was proposed by M. Chenell, seconded by A. Booton, that the minutes be accepted as a true record. Agreed unanimously.

**04.006: MATTERS ARISING.**

**BUS SERVICE; (03.118)** It was noted that the agreed contribution to the Bordon –Petersfield bus service should be £120. Cllr. Evans would seek to have the service routed through Petersfield Road, Greatham, rather than along Woolmer Road as at present, as a consequence of requests from bus-users.

**COUNSEL'S OPINION: (03.112)** Cllr Jerrard requested that the Counsel's opinion referred to be lodged with the Parish Council minutes, and this was unanimously agreed.

**04.007: FINANCIAL MATTERS.**

It was noted that the bank mandate was being amended in respect of new councillors, and that there were no other financial matters to discuss.

**04.008: PLANNING MATTERS.**

Cllr Jerrard tabled a Planning sub-committee Working Party report of 27/12/03, & spoke to it. Draft responses were tabled and agreed in respect of Farm Cottage, Greatham Moor (recommend refusal) and

Winfield, Church Lane (recommend grant), on proposal by D. Jerrard, seconded by A. Bridgman.

It was noted that a major revised application had been received in respect of Le Court Cheshire Home, with a response required by 14/1/04. Cllr. Bridgman suggested that, as the application would attract a detailed technical assessment at EHDC level, the Parish Council should focus on reflecting the views of the residents of Le Court, some of whom had claimed not to have been consulted. On proposal by Cllr. Jerrard, seconded by Cllr. Bridgman, it was agreed that Cllr. Jerrard should seek an extension of time to respond to the application, and that Cllr. Booton should arrange a meeting with Le Court residents.

Cllr. Jerrard proposed the adoption of the Working Party recommendation that Planning Committee meetings should be held at the Village Hall on the third Monday of each month, to permit public inspection of plans. This was seconded by Cllr. Booton, and unanimously agreed. Cllr Evans agreed to raise the issue with the Village Hall committee on 12/1/04.

**04.009: CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND.**

It was noted that all necessary repairs are in hand.

**04.010: APPOINTMENT of NEW CLERK.**

It was reported that no further progress had been made at this stage. A vote of thanks was proposed to Mrs Lyn Yeomans, who had acted as Clerk at the last meeting, and produced such excellent minutes.
