1.3 Summary

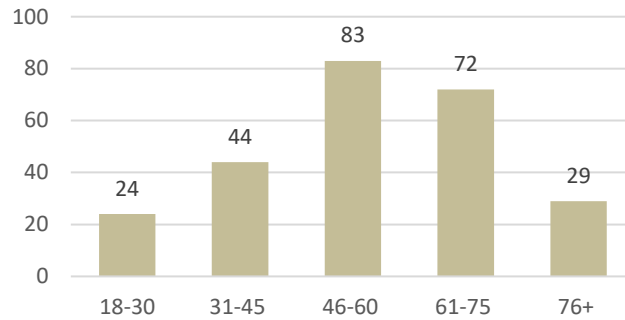

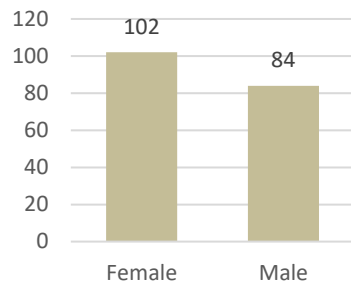

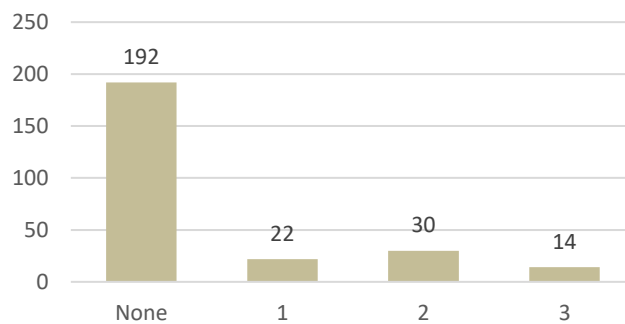
By Age



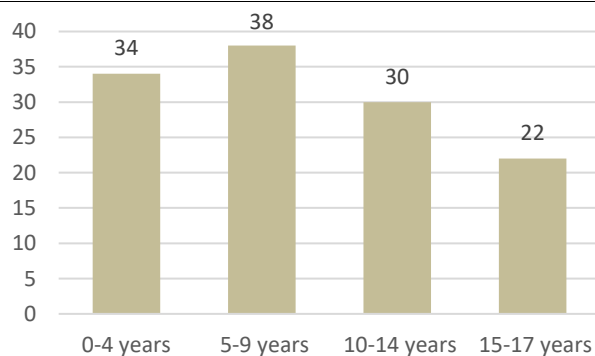

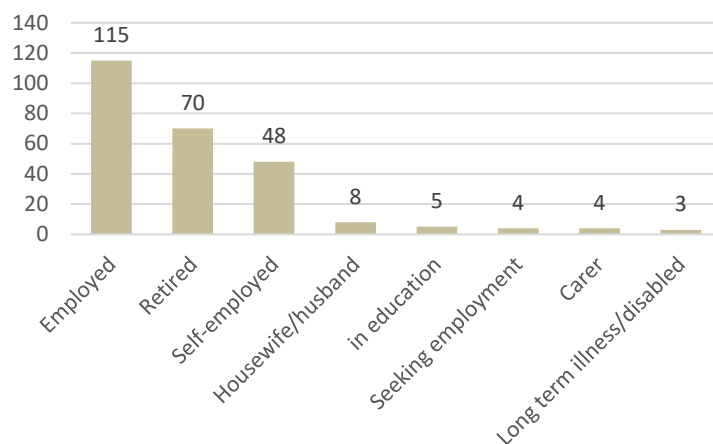
Number of children in your household?

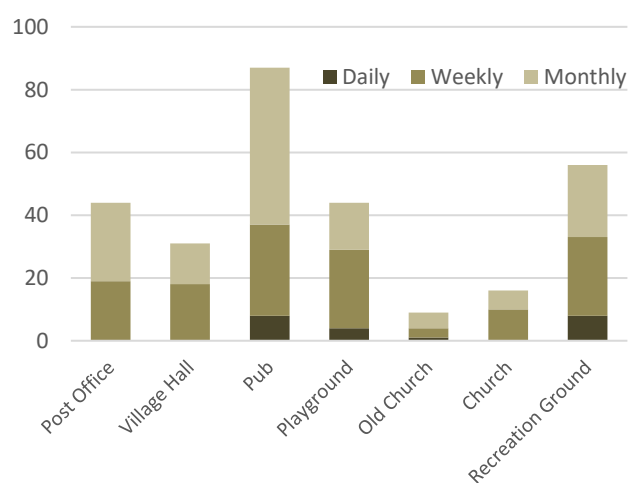

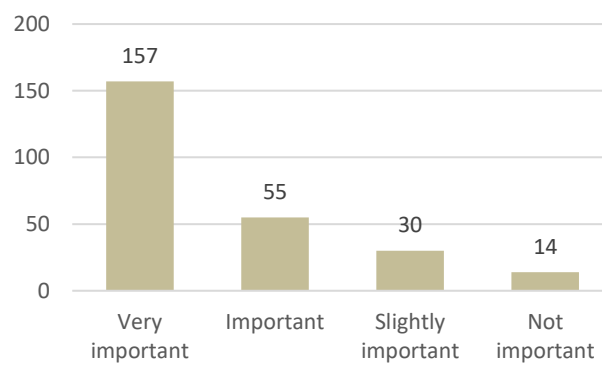

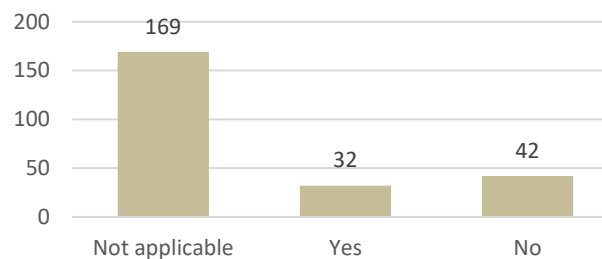
Our village pub, The Greatham Inn, is up for sale. How important is it to you that Greatham continues to have a pub?

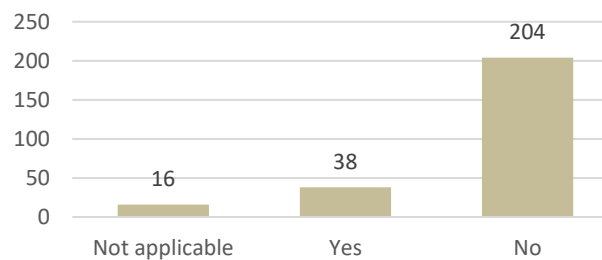


If you have a disability, do you find services and facilities in the village accessible?

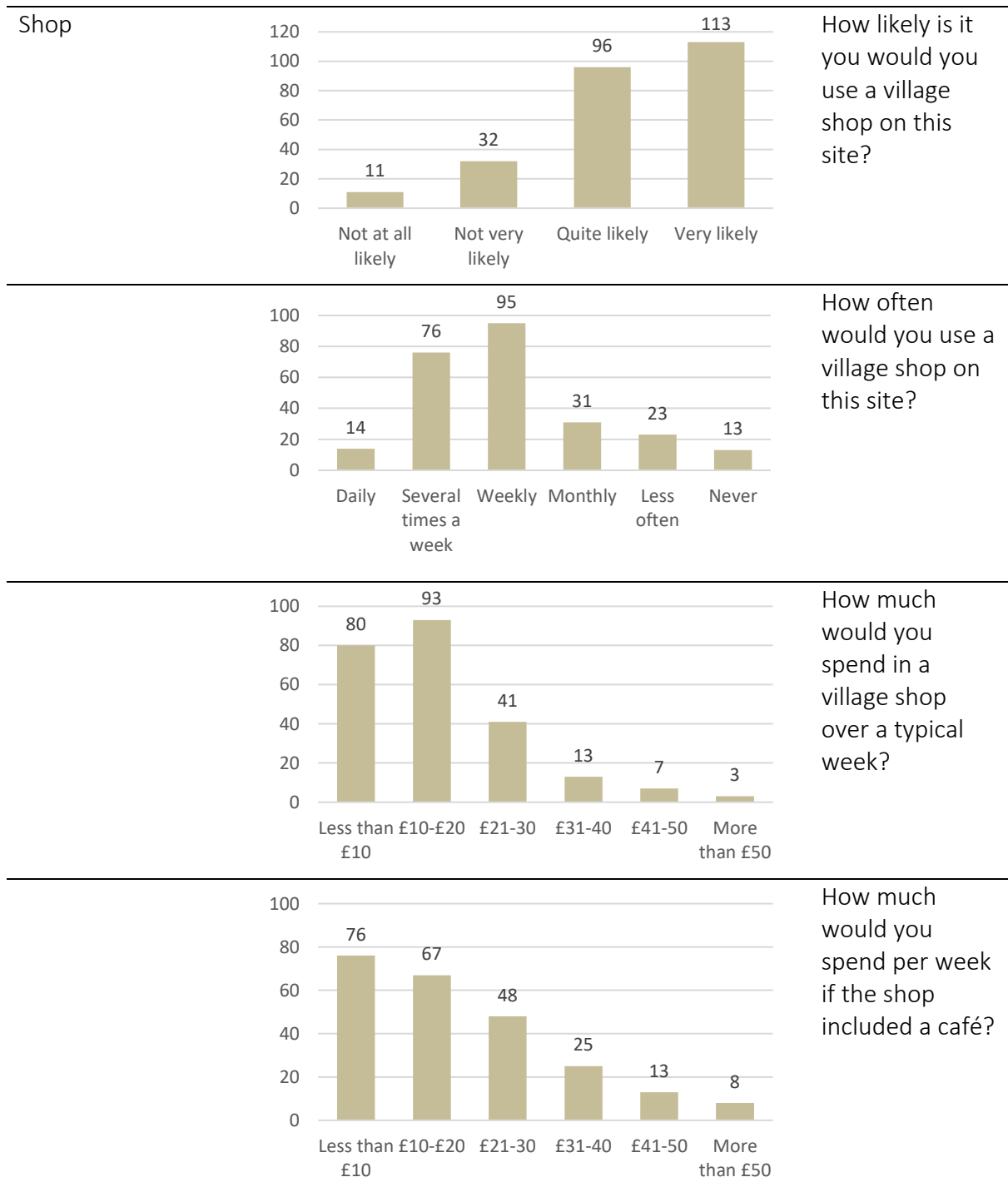


Would you be interested in accessing the internet at a central location in the village?

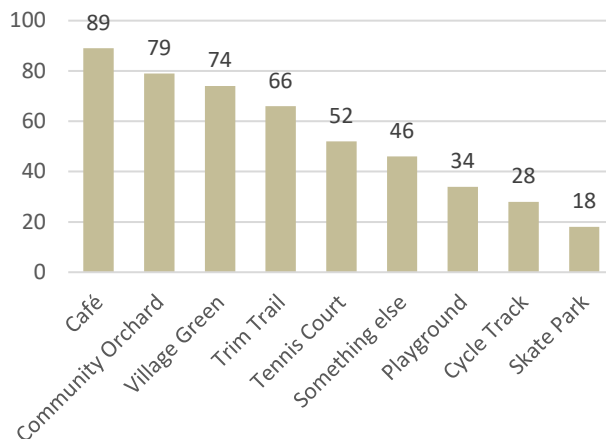

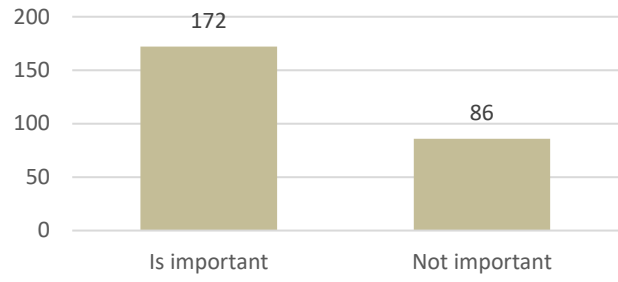

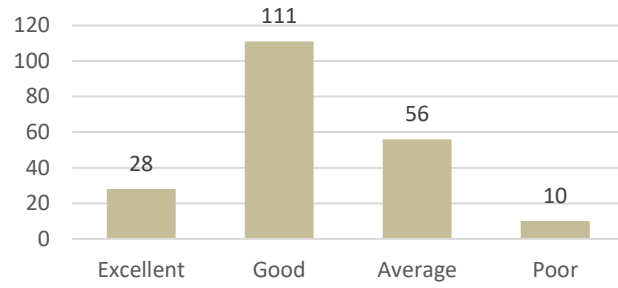
Playground at the Village Hall

Do you think the playground at the Village Hall is important?

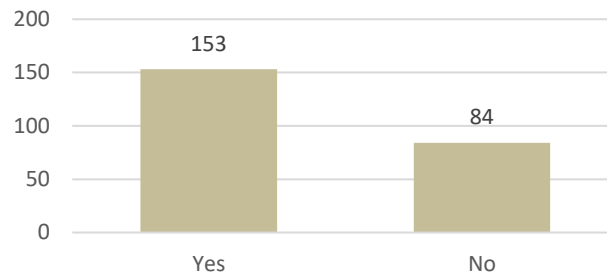

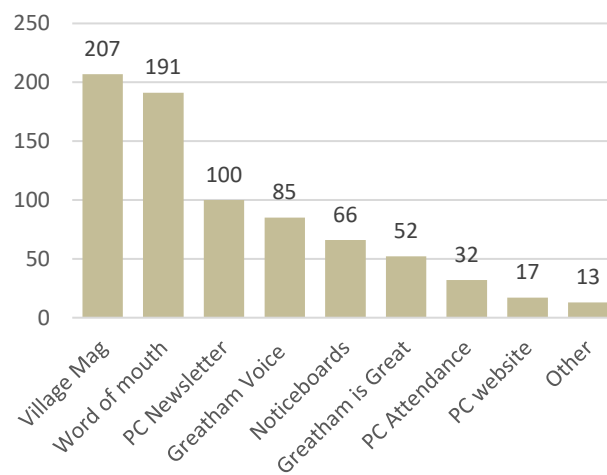

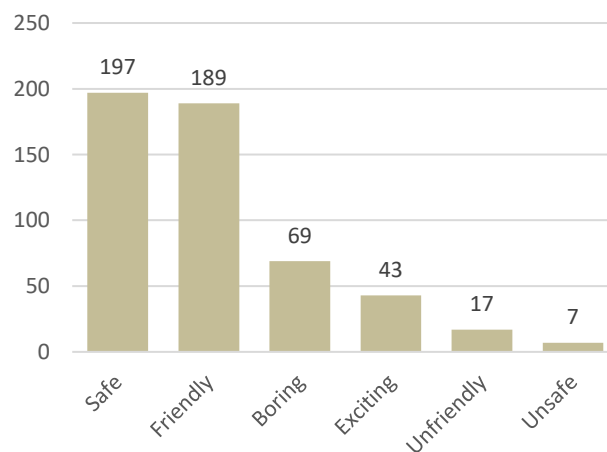
Do you feel involved in the community and know what is going on?

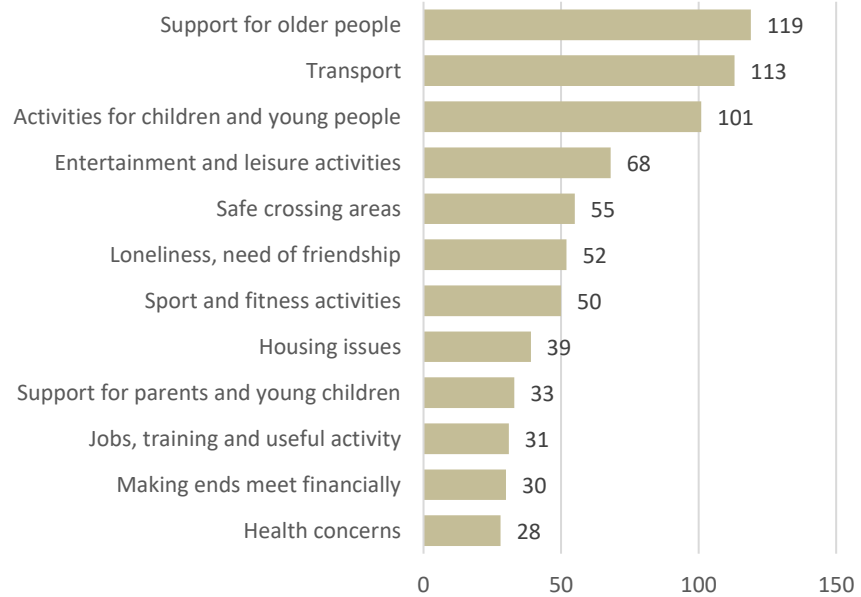

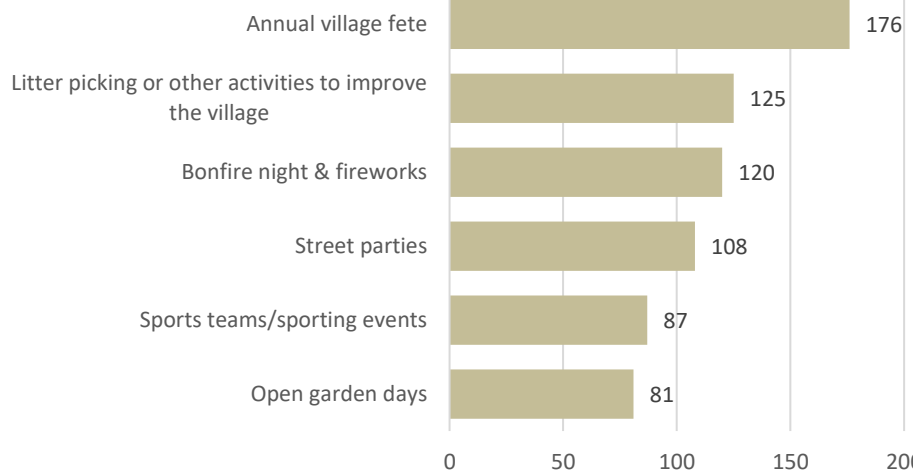


To what extent do the following words describe your feelings about Greatham?

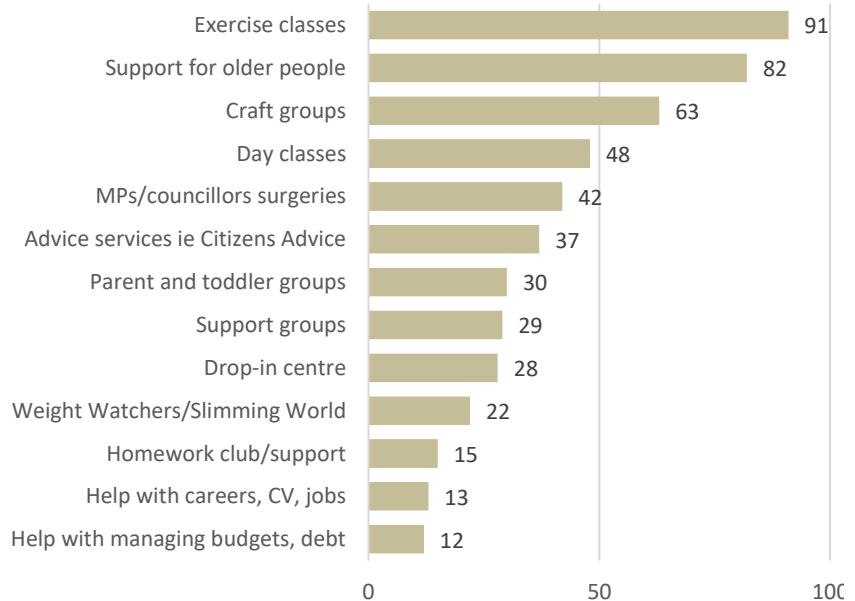
What do you think are the most important needs in the area?



How could a sense of community be improved?



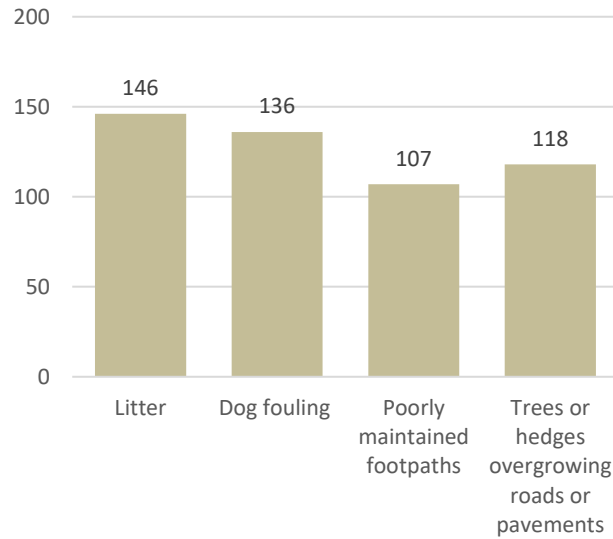

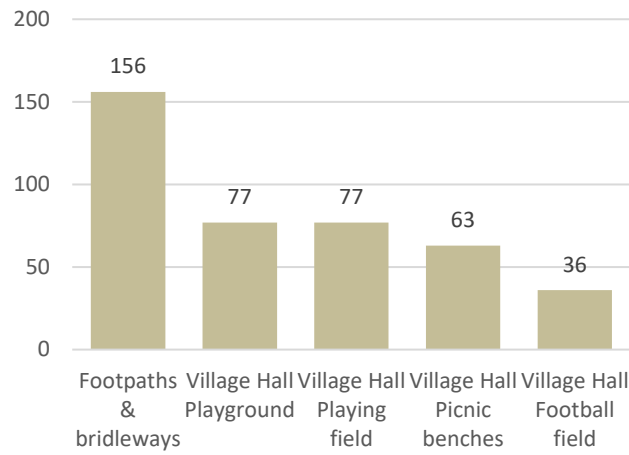

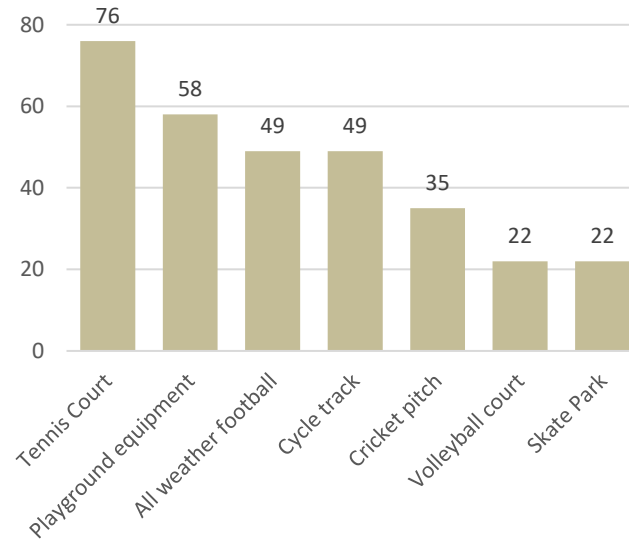

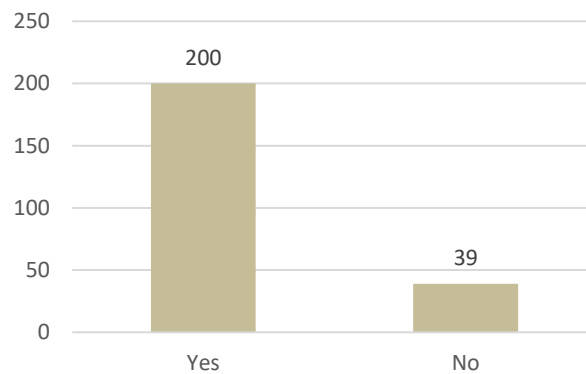

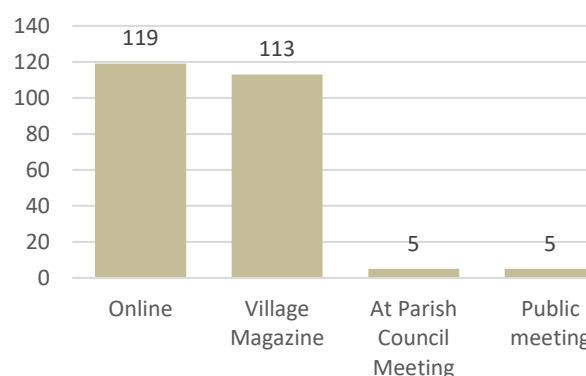


Do you know what Greatham Parish Council does?
